

Making a complaint against an Iyengar Yoga Teacher

The following information is for any person who wishes to make a complaint about an Iyengar Yoga teacher.

A complaint can only be investigated by the Ethics and Trademarks Committee (ETC) of Iyengar Yoga Australia (IYA) if:

- a. The complaint is against an Iyengar Yoga teacher or trainee teacher who is a financial member of IYA: and
- b. The complaint is about behaviour which is a breach of the IYA Teachers' Code of Conduct.

A complaint against a teacher or trainee teacher will be investigated by the Ethics and Trademarks Committee in accordance with the IYA Complaints Handling Procedure.

Please note where the ETC is satisfied a complaint discloses evidence that a criminal offence has been committed by a teacher that complaint will, unless exceptional circumstances exist, be referred to police.

A complaint can be made by completing and submitting the Complaints Form against a Teacher, which can be found on the [IYA](#) website.

You will receive notification that your complaint has been received within the next 7 days.
